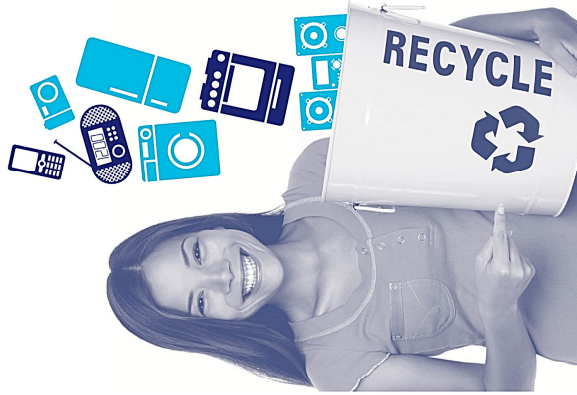

ITEM	ACCEPTED	NOT ACCEPTED
Appliances & Scrap Metal	Washers, dryers, dishwashers, ovens, stoves, water heaters, engines, microwaves, BBOs, lawn mowers, metal lawn chairs, swing sets, cast iron sinks and tubs, auto parts, iron, steel, aluminum (cans included), brass, copper & other ferrous and non-ferrous metals.	NO metals that are insulated, rubber coated, oily, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials. NO light fixture ballasts. NO sealed drums.
Refrigerators, Freezers & Air Conditioners	Refrigerators, freezers, and portable household air conditioners.	NO industrial fridges and freezers.
Toilets & Sinks	Toilet seat, base, and wax ring must be removed.	
Electronic Equipment	DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cellular phones (remove personal information), CPUs, and computer peripherals such as keyboards and mice.	NO computer monitors, laptops or TVs. Take these to Kent Goodwill Stores. Any day, no charge.
Cardboard	Please flatten.	NO wax-coated cardboard.
Batteries	Car, truck, marine, motorcycle and cellphone batteries. Alkaline Batteries AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, D and rechargeable cell batteries.	NO Ni-cads
Lead Acid Batteries	Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.	
Propane Tanks	Residential tanks only.	
Tires	Light truck, car and motorcycle tires. Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 8 passenger tires per vehicle (18 inches and below) free of charge.	Tires on rims - \$3.00 each. Cash only.
Bulky Yard Debris	Logs and large branches greater than four inches in diameter.	NO brush, sod, grass clippings, blackberry bushes, leaves, small branches, rocks or stumps.
Scrap Wood	Clean wood and pallets. Place on tarp for easy removal. No need to remove nails.	NO painted, stained, treated or laminated wood or particle board.
Reusable Household Goods	Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. All items must be clean and in good enough condition for resale by a charitable organization.	NO broken, torn, stained, damaged or wet items. NO furniture or carpet.
Styrofoam and Packing Peanuts	White styrofoam blocks. Expanded polystyrene styrofoam only. Packing peanuts (any color). Look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol. Peanuts need to be in box or bag. Clean and dry materials only.	NO urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation.

NO flatbeds or dump trucks allowed. Vendors reserve the right to refuse oversized, commercial, contaminated, excessive or unacceptable loads.

DON'T BRING THESE HOUSEHOLD WASTES:

- NO construction/demolition debris
- NO plastics
- NO latex paint (see note below)
- NO plastic pools, toys, hoses, etc.
- NO painted/treated wood
- NO Mattresses
- NO grass, leaves, or small yard debris
- NO garbage
- NO window glass/mirrors
- NO carpeting
- NO concrete, rock, brick or asphalt

Dry out latex paint and dispose of the can in the garbage with the lid off. Larger amounts can be dried out by adding equal amounts of cat litter or paint hardener. Larger amounts can also be shared with friends or donated to a local theatre group. Full cans can be donated to Habitat for Humanity at 206.292.5240.

DON'T BRING THESE HAZARDOUS WASTES:

- NO paint of any kind
- NO solvents and thinners
- NO cleaning products
- NO motor oil
- NO antifreeze
- NO pesticides/herbicides
- NO household chemicals
- NO fluorescent lights
- NO oil filters

Household hazardous waste can be disposed of at the Wastemobile in Auburn at The Outlet Collection (formerly known as the SuperMall) 10am-5pm, every Saturday and Sunday, near the loading docks and Sports Authority. Segregate motor oil (crankcase oil) from all other liquids including brake fluid, hydraulic fluid, transmission fluid, etc.
