Traffic control plans will be reviewed to accommodate non-peak public usage for both lane closure restrictions and pedestrian access.

For use of City-owned poles in the public right-of-way or City-owned property, including the use of ground space, base station, or any other infrastructure in the public right-of way, provide proof of a valid Agreement with the City with the Agreement number and date signed or when the agreement is completed if it is being processed concurrently.

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
