## Recycling

Place clean and empty items loose in cart, not bagged or in boxes.



Paper  
Cartons & Boxes  
Flattened Cardboard  
Coated Paper  
Glass Bottles & Jars  
Cans  
Aluminum Foil  
Scrap Metal (2ftx2ftx2ft)  
Plastic Cups & Tubs  
Plastic Jugs & Bottles  
Lids (3" or larger)

**\*No Food. No Liquid.  
No Plastic Bags.  
No Sharp Metals. No Wood.  
No Clothing, Textiles, or Shoes.**

## Food & Yard Waste

Leave items unbagged unless using Cedar Grove-approved compostable bags.



Meat, Fish, Dairy  
Bones & Shells  
Coffee Grounds & Filters  
Pasta, Bread, Grains, Rice  
Compostable Items  
Paper Towels & Napkins  
Uncoated Paper Plates  
Uncoated Paper Cups  
Waxed Cardboard  
Food Paper Products (uncoated)  
Greasy Pizza Boxes  
Grass, Weeds, & Leaves  
Branches (less than 4ftx4in)

**\*No Plastic. No Metal.  
No Produce Stickers.  
No Glass. No Animal Waste.  
No Tissue/Hygiene Products.**

## Garbage **No Recyclables. No Toxic/Hardous Materials.**



Styrofoam Containers  
Packing Peanuts (bagged)  
Unusable Ceramics & Glassware  
Plastic Utensils and Straws  
Incandescent Light Bulbs  
Lids & Caps (less than 3 in wide)  
Soiled Coated Paper  
Soiled Plastic Containers  
Ziploc, Food, and Single Bags  
Fats, Oils, & Greases (in container)\*  
Clothing, Textiles, and Shoes\*  
Tissues & Hygiene Products  
Diapers and Animal Waste (bagged)  
Candy Wrappers & Snack Bags  
Paint Cans (lid off, dried & empty)  
Empty Toxic Containers
