WILL NOT ACCEPT: Rechargeable, cell phone, NiCad, Lithium-ion batteries (Visit KingCountyHazWasteWA.gov or Call2Recycle.org for more battery recycling options.)

Styrofoam

Blocks: Expanded polystyrene only. Look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol. Clean and dry material only. No tape, labels or stickers.

Blocks and packing peanuts: Must be clean, dry and contained in clear/white bags or boxes. Vendor reserves right to refuse any item.

WILL NOT ACCEPT:

Urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation.

WILL NOT ACCEPT:

No Vacuums

Vacuums, TVs and monitors: drop off at E-Cycle Washington sites (Kent Goodwill or Value Village). See **EcycleWA.gov** for more locations and a full list of accepted electronics.

Concrete, Asphalt, Rock & Brick

Place on tarp for easy removal. Rocks and smaller materials must be in small boxes or buckets. Remove plastic, metal and wood. Residential material only, 2 load

WILL NOT ACCEPT:

Mattresses & Box Springs

Mattresses and box springs only, any size. All items must be clean and dry. Please cover in the event of rain. 4-piece limit. No commercial loads.

WILL NOT ACCEPT:

Futons, wet or soiled items, furniture, frames. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item deemed unacceptable or unrecyclable.

Household Refrigerators, **Freezers**

· Limit 2 per vehicle

WILL NOT ACCEPT:

Industrial refrigerators and freezers

- Accessories
 Clothes
 Linens
- Shoes Stuffed tovs

WILL NOT ACCEPT:

Cushions, pillows, wet or mildewed items, or household items.

Household Air Conditioners, **Dehumidifiers**

petroleum-based products

• Limit 2 per vehicle

Porcelain Toilets and Sinks

Toilet seats and base wax rings must be removed. Limit 2 toilets per vehicle.

Scrap Metal

- Aluminum
- Auto parts
- BBQs
- Brass Cast iron sinks & tubs
- Copper
- Dishwashers
- Dryers Engines
- Ferrous Metals
- Lawn mowers (remove gas and oil)
- Metal lawn chairs
- Microwaves
- Non-ferrous metals
- Ovens Steel
- Stoves Swing sets
- Washers Water heaters

WILL NOT ACCEPT:

Metals that are insulated, rubber-coated, oily, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint or hazardous materials. Light fixture ballasts or sealed drums.

Propane Tanks

- Empty residential tanks
- Empty camping stove tanks
- Limit 2, 5-gallon tanks per vehicle

Shredding

Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Staples okay. No binder clips.

LIMIT: 4 file-size (12"x12"x16") boxes or equivalent quantity per vehicle – no

Bulky Yard Debris and Scrap Wood

- Branches (greater than 4" diameter)
- Clean wood and plywood
- Pallets

All wood should be unpainted, untreated, and unstained. Please lay a tarp under materials for easy removal.

WILL NOT ACCEPT:

Blackberry bushes, brush, grass clippings leaves, painted, stained, treated or laminated wood or particle board, small branches, sod or stumps.
