Food Trucks in Kent

To operate a food truck in Kent, all vendors must have:

1. A Mobile Food Service Permit from the King County Department of Public Health.

- **2.** A **Business License** to operate in the City of Kent, renewed annually: (you only need one (1) of these):
 - If the business is <u>based in Kent</u> (operated in conjunction with a restaurant, for example), you need a **Commercial Business License:** Business Licenses | City of Kent (kentwa.gov)
 - If the business is <u>based outside of Kent</u>, but operates in the City, you need an **Outside Contractor** <u>License</u>: <u>Business Licenses | City of Kent (kentwa.gov)</u>
 - If the business is <u>run out of a home</u> located in the City of Kent, you need a **Home Occupation Business License:** <u>Business Licenses</u> | <u>City of Kent (kentwa.gov)</u>

An **additional City of Kent permit** *may be* required, depending on where the mobile food business will be operating/ vending:

• If <u>parked in one location</u> for an extended period of time (by agreement with the property owner), you need a **City of Kent Temporary Use Permit**:

Temporary Uses are regulated under Kent City Code 15.08.205 http://www.codepublishing.com/wa/kent/?Kent15/Kent1508.html#15.08.205

Temporary uses are limited to 90 days, and may not occupy City parks or public lands without approval. If operating in a parking lot, the business may not occupy more than 25% of the parking spaces.

• If moving from place to place, but vending on City streets and other rights-of-way, you need a City of Kent Street Use Permit: Appy via the permitting portal here.

Street vendors are regulated under Kent City Code 6.07.060 http://www.codepublishing.com/WA/Kent/?Kent06/Kent0607.html#6.07.060

Street vendors may only operate in commercial and industrial zones. They also may not operate within 200 feet of a business selling similar products, and may not operate within 200 feet of a park or public school without written consent.

If <u>moving from place to place</u>, but vending **ONLY on PRIVATE PROPERTY**, you do not need any
additional permits from the City of Kent. You only need the King County Mobile Food Service
Permit and a City of Kent Business License.
