Keep your yard and community Clean, when Kent goes Green.

Once again the City of Kent is teaming up with its residents and Republic Services to clean up the city. With its annual "Fall Clean-up" program, residents may rid themselves of extra yard waste and garbage.

Note: No construction, demolition debris. No rocks, concrete, bricks, asphalt.

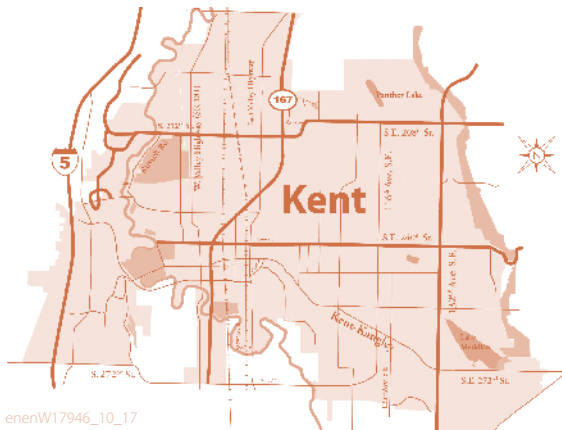
The event is **free** to all residential households within the Kent city limits who participate in curbside garbage services.

Place your extra garbage, trash and yard waste at the curb **on your regular yard waste pick-up day during your Yard Waste week of Nov 6-10 or Nov 13-17 (including Veterans Day).**

If your refuse isn't picked-up, call Republic Services at **206-682-9735** on the following day to notify them of missed collection (for a Friday missed pick up, call the following Monday).

Note: Extra items placed out at curb and collected other than during your Yard Waste week of Nov 6-10 or Nov 13-17 will be charged as extra garbage and/or yard waste.

Garbage & Trash

- Place your extra garbage/trash at the curb on your yard waste day only. (If items are not collected by your regular garbage truck, they will be collected by another truck).
- All garbage/trash must be in bags, boxes (no more than 3'x3'x3') or cans marked garbage. **No loose trash will be picked up!**
- Each bag/box/can must weigh less than **60 pounds** or it will not be collected.
- No appliances or furniture will be accepted. Contact Republic Services at **206-682-9735** to schedule pick up of these items—fees apply.
- **Limit of 10 units garbage** (1 unit=32 gallon can, a bag, or box)



Make Your Own Plant Food!

Chop or shred yard waste by running over it with your lawnmower. Add vegetable and fruit scraps (no meat as it attracts rodents). Make sure ingredients are moist but not soaking wet. Load mixture into a bin or stack in a pile and **let nature take its course**. Organisms already in the material, along with insects and worms will break it all down into a nutrient-rich soil to spread in flower beds and elsewhere.

Yard Waste

- Place yard waste, including leaves, grass, brush, tree wood waste and branches (not to exceed 4" in diameter or 4' in length) in containers marked "Yard Waste" at the curb **on your regular yard waste pick-up day.**
- Material not fitting into the green yard waste cart can be placed into cans, cardboard boxes, or paper yard waste bags (available at most hardware stores). *Note: Paper bags disintegrate if left out too long in the rain, please don't place them at the curb until 7 a.m. to avoid spillage.* Branches can be bundled with natural fiber rope or twine – no plastic please. Containers and bundles can weigh no more than 60 pounds each. **Plastic bags will not be accepted.**
- **Please Note:** Food waste may only be placed in the contractor-supplied green cart.
- **Limit of 10 units yard waste** (1 unit=32 gallon can, paper bag, or cardboard box measuring no more than 3'x3'x3', or a bundle no more than 2'x2'x4')
- All yard waste collected will be processed into compost.

Note: Extra items placed at the curb and collected other than during your Yard Waste week between Nov 6-17, will be charged as extra garbage and/or yard waste. Materials not meeting the listed guidelines will not be picked up.
